October 11, 2022: Deadline to register to vote.

### **Voting**

Vote-by-mail is an option available to all voters.

**October 12, 2022:** In-person early voting begins, and ballots are mailed.

**October 28, 2022:** Deadline of 5:00 p.m. to request a ballot-by-mail.

November 4, 2022: In-person early voting ends.

**November 8, 2022:** Election Day and deadline of 7:00 p.m. to return voted ballot-by-mail.

## **ID Requirements**

Identification is required for all voters.

## **Polling Place Details**

Polling places are open from 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
