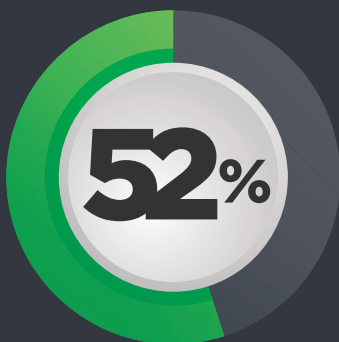

**October 11, 2022:** Registration Deadline

## Voting

Voting early and absentee by mail is an option available to all voters.

**October 17, 2022:** Early voting begins.

**October 28, 2022:** Absentee ballot request deadline.

**November 4, 2022:** Early voting ends.

**November 8, 2022:** Election Day and 7:00 p.m. deadline to return voted absentee ballot.

## ID Requirements

Georgia law requires photo identification when voting, either in person or absentee.

Polling places are open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
