October 24, 2022: Voter registration deadline. Same day registration and voting available.

Voting

Voting absentee is an option available to all voters.

October 19, 2022: In-person absentee voting available.

October 24, 2022: Deadline to request absentee ballot of 5:00 p.m.

November 7, 2022: In-person absentee voting ends.

November 8, 2022: Election Day and deadline to return absentee ballot by 8:00 p.m.

ID Requirements

Iowa voters are required to show identification when voting absentee in-person or at the polls on Election Day.

Polling Place Details:

Polling places are open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
