Register

October 12: Voter registration deadline.

Voting

In-person early voting and voting by mail are available to all voters.

September 18: Voting by mail begins.

October 23: In-person early voting begins.

October 26: Deadline to submit a mail-in ballot request by mail.

October 31: In-person early voting ends.

November 1: Deadline to submit a mail-in ballot request in-person.

November 2: Election Day and deadline of 8 p.m. to return a mail-in ballot in-person.

Mail-in ballots must be postmarked by Election Day and received by November 8.

ID Requirements

New Jersey does not require voters to present ID while voting. First time voters may need to present valid ID if registration is incomplete.

Polling Place Details

Polling places are open from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Election Day. During the early voting period, in-person voting will be held Monday-Saturday, 10 a.m. to 8 p.m., and Sunday, 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.
