## Register

**October 12:** Voter registration deadline.

## Voting

In-person early voting and absentee voting are available to all voters throughout the Commonwealth.

**September 17:** In-person early voting begins.

**October 22:** Deadline of 5 p.m. to apply for an absentee ballot by mail.

**October 30:** In-person early voting ends.

**November 2:** Election Day and deadline of 7 p.m. to return absentee ballots in-person. Absentee ballots returned by mail must be postmarked by Election Day and received by noon on November 5.

## ID Requirements

Virginia law requires all voters to provide either an acceptable form of ID or sign an ID Confirmation Statement at the polls. For a detailed list of acceptable IDs, contact your local elections officials.

## Polling Place Details

Polling places are open from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. If you have questions regarding your polling location, contact your local elections office.
